The **Housing Industry Association** has submitted an application under the Enterprise Based Productivity Places Program (EBPPP) for existing workers – a funding initiative of the Federal Government. If successful, the intended Program would provide the opportunity for your organisation to receive funding – enabling your employees to undertake training and obtain a Certificate IV qualification in either Site Management or Estimating, through the Housing Industry Association. With the government contributing up to 90% of the cost, you can pay as little as \$550 **per person for a company with less than 100 employees\***.
